Please study the attached schedule carefully. The first **parent/student meeting and rehearsal on Sunday, September 8** is mandatory (for both you and a parent or guardian) and extremely important! We will answer your questions and prepare you for your **audition in octets on September 21 or 22**. If you are chosen to be in Senior Honors Choir, you will be expected to be present for all rehearsals and performances. Please check the scheduled Honors Choir dates with your school calendar along with concert dates, musical rehearsals, prom and anything else that may be a conflict. We strongly urge you to participate in your school's choral program, and if a school activity (music, sports, musicals, etc.) conflicts directly at the same time with an Honors Choir performance or rehearsal, you will be excused from your Honors Choir commitment for that day. Your continuing membership in Honors Choir will depend on your ability to arrange your work and personal social schedule, and reliably communicate with us, so that you can be a dependable, consistent member of the Senior Honors Choir.

Choir members will be asked for a non-refundable registration fee of \$40. The remaining \$120 tuition will be payable after your successful audition. We will be wearing the same formal outfits that we wore this year. If you must replace your entire formal outfit, the additional cost will be \$95. Beyond that, there is no additional cost for membership in the Senior Honors Choir, thanks to our generous patrons and sponsors. If for any reason you cannot meet the financial obligations, please see our website [www.theYCHC.org](http://www.theYCHC.org), click on Forms and select "Scholarship Request Form for Junior and Senior Honors Choir" to complete the necessary paperwork. Please do not let financial concerns prevent you from being a part of the Honors Choirs.

➤ On June 26-28, 2020, Junior and Senior Honors Choir are invited to participate in the Choirs of America Nationals for Top Choirs at Carnegie Hall in New York City. Choir members will have an exciting opportunity for choral education clinics and feature performance opportunities. Please know that there is an additional cost for this trip (at this time trip fee is estimated at \$680), and an installment payment plan will be offered. Trip scholarship request forms will be available if for any reason you cannot meet the financial obligation. The trip is not mandatory, but our Executive Director will see that every choir member can participate if they are available. An informational meeting about the Carnegie Hall trip will be held on Tuesday, May 28, 7:00 p.m. at Zion UMC, 1030 Carlisle Road, York, PA 17404. Parents and students may attend if you are registered for Senior Honors Choir or uncertain about registration at this time.
